A MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN



I wanted to provide an update to all members as we enter the spring months, with the cricket season fast approaching.

Following the AGM, it was good to see a healthy turnout once more, albeit not so many of our younger members. We seem to talk a lot about the “good old days”, and I am guilty of that, as are many others, but we all have to recognise that life and the world have changed.

The days of me giving the Shorts and the Randalls some drinks and sweets to score for the first team are long gone; it is now a £1,500 cost to the club every year. Most things are now a cost, and the only way we can continue to grow as a club is to ask people to contribute more in memberships, obtain grants, receive kind sponsorships and/or gain more volunteers

Your committee is reviewing all of the above and has plans in place to make sure we tap into every opportunity. We are already extremely grateful for three sponsors secured for 2026: MOONWALK FLOORING, SHIELD SECURITY and EASTENDERZ. All are kindly making significant donations towards the new playing shirts across senior and junior cricket. The juniors also have some targets to achieve to raise money, which will go towards club projects.

And yes, we do play cricket, and most people know my views on this... we want to be better, improve our youngsters, attract new talent and be a successful club. Success will be measured differently, but for me it is about being very competitive at each level at which we are playing, with the first team being the most important. Winning games breeds competitiveness, people committed to play and train, which in turn means a positive summer atmosphere, teams enjoying the club facilities and then spending some money over the bar. I will be the first to buy the teams a jug of beer for doing well on Saturdays, for those officially allowed to drink! It is also the football World Cup, so please look out for the dates. The timing of the games looks favourable, and I am sure Kerry will look to put some promotions on behind the bar. The alcoholic cocktails and slush puppies should flow, the new coffee machine will be on for those driving, and hopefully we will find a few volunteers to get the BBQ going. I have even heard Scotland have qualified, so there may be a few other dates to look out for — probably just three games!

On the cricketing front, Nick will update you on some new recruits and some people returning, which will really help strengthen the top end of our playing group and then filter down to improve the other sides. Please do not come running to selection if you are left out due to not training or performing, or because of poor availability; we want to create a competitive feel within the club. We will also have an Australian overseas player this year, who should join us in mid-April. As you always do, please make him welcome, buy him a pint and have a chat — he will be around the club all summer.

Lara is continuing to lead the ladies’ set-up and, although some of the numbers have reduced, this remains an important area for the club. If you know any girls or ladies who want to try cricket or fancy a new club and a change of scenery, then please do reach out. All fixtures and training details will be on Spond and the website.

I may have missed a few things, but if I have, hopefully others will cover them later in the newsletter. I look forward to keeping you updated on events and thank you for your continued support. We are also extremely grateful to Kerry Coughlan for agreeing to take over the role that Stuart and Alan have been performing for a number of years, overseeing the bar and hirings. Expect some new energy and enthusiasm, and be prepared for change — hopefully in a positive way. If you are prepared to help in any way, have ideas to raise money, can offer some voluntary work each week, know someone who could assist with projects around the club, or support new ideas for social functions, then please do get in touch, as all support will be welcomed and reviewed positively.

We are continuing to review some clubhouse improvements, and I must apologise for the delay in upgrading the ladies' toilets. I promise you that the Executive has been looking at this for over 15 months, and the most appropriate source of income was a grant, which in turn changed its criteria for applications and was then postponed until this year. We are reapplying and will report back to all members with updates. Failing this, we will review alternative solutions.

The main feedback we receive is that the clubhouse is looking a “bit tired”. During the last quarter of 2025, we set up a small project team to review this and look at costs, particularly for the main area downstairs and the bar. We have some indicative costs and will continue these discussions at the next Executive meeting later in March. This is a tricky one, as we all feel we can generate better value and increased income from the improvements, but the cash in the bank does not allow for such significant expenditure. All solutions are again being discussed, and we will report back ahead of the cricket season.

You can all help improve our cash flow to enable us to make quicker decisions and keep bar prices down. Please pay your memberships on time; cricketers, pay your match fees; buy some 200 Club tickets — this can be as little as £5 a month, with good cash prizes; come to some of the social events and spend money over the bar, appreciating that I am as guilty as many during the cold winter months of hibernating! However, the committee and I are kept busy with many other weekly duties that may not be visible, so please do not think that not being seen at times means time has stopped at CCC.

I'm looking forward to getting going.


I'm looking forward to captaining the 3rd XI again this season and building on where we finished last year, with the goal of pushing for another promotion.


there should be healthy competition for places throughout the club as players filter down the sides. That can only be a positive thing, as it helps raise standards and gives everyone something to push for.


